Important Note for Students & Parents

Discipline, regular attendance, and responsible behavior are the foundations of a successful academic journey. To ensure a positive and safe learning environment, all students must adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Discipline Guidelines

- Any serious and inexcusable act of indiscipline will result in the opening of a Red File against the student.
- If a student's name is registered **three times** in the Red File, they will face **termination** from the school.
- In cases of **serious offences**, immediate termination may be enforced depending on the gravity of the situation.
- All students are expected to uphold the values of respect, honesty, and responsibility at all times.

2. Attendance Policy

- A minimum of **75% attendance** is mandatory for all students.
- Students failing to meet the required attendance may be barred from exams and school activities.
- Attendance shortfalls will only be excused up to a certain extent in case of medical emergencies with proper documentation.

3. Bag Checking

- To maintain discipline and safety, the school will conduct **random bag checks**.
- Students are strictly prohibited from carrying any objectionable or unauthorized items to school.
- Any student found with prohibited items will face disciplinary action.

4. Social Media Awareness

- Students are advised not to use social media and prioritize their academics and character development over digital distractions.
